SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS: PART ONE

VCC PRINCIPLES & INTENT

The VCC Time-Trial is for current financial members of the Vintage Car Club NZ (Inc) (VCC) who have a road legal car with a current VCC Vehicle Identity Card (VIC).

A **Road Book** is provided to aid with navigation on the event.

The Road Book also contains a "Slippery Surface" (yellow & red) and an "OK" (green) sign.

This is not a speed event, but rather an exercise in precise driving & time-keeping to maintain a set average speed through all closed stages - Speeding and Accidents will not be tolerated and may result in exclusion.

1. JURISDICTION

This event is a Time-Trial, promoted by Targa (Promotions) NZ Ltd on behalf of the Vintage Car Club of NZ (Inc.) and will take place on **Monday 22nd to Saturday 27th October 2018 in the Southland, Otago & Central Otago Regions, (with prizegiving Sunday morning 28th October).**

The **VCC Time-Trial 2018** will be held in conjunction with Club Targa Inc and forms part of the **Targa NZ 2018** event.

The Time-Trial will be held under these **Supplementary Regulations**, the relevant sections of the **2018 Targa NZ Seria Campione Sanctioned Articles** and the **VCC NZ Branch Manual Section 20**.

3. THE EVENT

VCC Time-Trial 2018 is a five (5) day Tarmac Time-Trial event, which is part of the 2018 Targa NZ Seria Campione.

3.1 Venue:

There are thirty three (33) stages.

Evening Service Stops are at Invercargill (Monday/Tuesday), Dunedin (Wednesday/Thursday) & Queenstown (Friday/Saturday).

3.2 Length: Comprises of **587 km** of special stages and **1300 km** of touring.

4. ENTRIES

4.1 Entry Fees

Early bird entry fee (if paid by 30th June 2018) \$2,200 + GST
Standard entry fee (if paid from 1st July 2018) \$2,500 +GST

In addition-:

A medical levy of \$490 +GST
RallySafe GPS tracking and timing \$300 +GST

4.2 Entries open on publication of these Supplementary Regulations and close at 5:00pm on Friday 28th September 2018.

4.3 Entry Acceptance: Entries shall be made on the correct Entry Form and to be deemed valid **MUST** be complete in all details with fully signed Indemnity Form accompanied by the appropriate fees. Acceptance will be at the Organising Committee discretion.

4.4 Number of Starters:

The maximum number of VCC Time-Trial starters will be **50**. Any additional entries received will be placed on the reserve list in order of receipt.

The organisers reserve the right to abandon the main Targa event if less than **20** entries are received at normal closing date.

4.5 Competitor Requirements:

(1) Knowledge and Understandings: In signing the entry forms, Competitors (Entrant and Drivers/Co-drivers/Navigators) are deemed to fully understand the VCC NZ Branch Manual and its relevant Sections, particularly Section 20 "Instructions to Rally Organisers".

(2) Licence Requirements: Both Driver & Co-driver/Navigator shall hold a current full NZ Civil Drivers Licence or overseas equivalent.

5. ELIGIBLE VEHICLES

5.1 Compliance: All vehicles shall be NZ road legal and comply with the requirements of VCC NZ with a current VIC & minimum Third Party Insurance, (proof of which will be required at Scrutineering prior to Documentation). All vehicles must have a crew of two persons – Driver & Co-driver/Navigator. Passengers are not permitted.

5.2 Safety/Recovery: All vehicles must have securely mounted a reflective Warning triangle, First aid kit, Tow rope (with preferably clearly visible/identified towing eyes/straps front & rear) and Fire extinguisher (min 1kg within reach of driver/co-driver).

5.3 Sensible Safety: This is not a speed event, however crash helmets, fire resistant overalls, underwear, socks, gloves and leather shoes are strongly recommended for closed road stages.

For cars with roll protection, crash helmets must be worn on closed road stages.

For cars with a full safety harness fitted, a HANS device is strongly recommended.

5.4 Tyres: Tyres must be suitable for legal road use.

5.5 RallySafe GPS: 'RallySafe' tracking and timing technology will be used at this event. An overview of the system which provides significant safety benefits can be found on www.rallysafe.com.au

A one off cost of approximately \$AUD210 (plus shipping) to purchase an installation kit (wiring, brackets and aerials). These must be ordered from RallySafe using the online purchase form found at www.rallysafe.com.au

NOTE: Please make sure that you have ordered and received a wiring kit at least four weeks prior to the event.

Your vehicle must be fitted with an operational RallySafe device. This device must be switched on from Scrutineering through until the end of the event.

Failure to comply will incur a penalty as set out in the 2018 Targa NZ Seria Campione Sanctioned Series Articles Art 16.2.20.

5.5 Competitors: VCC Time-Trial Vehicles will be divided into the following classes:

Class A	Average 50kmph
Class B	Average 70kmph

6. SCRUTINEERING, DOCUMENTATION AND DRIVERS BRIEFING

Competitors **must** present their car for Scrutineering prior to processing through to Documentation for the **checking of current full Civil Driver Licences & VCC Membership, vehicle registration & WOF, VCC Vehicle Identity Card & minimum Third Party Insurance.**

6.1 Scrutineering will take place on **Monday 22nd October** as follows:

- Venue: Invercargill
- Time: 10:00am – 2:00pm

You must complete Scrutineering within this time slot unless arranged prior with the Main Targa Event Secretary. All Crews must attend Scrutineering and cannot go directly to Documentation.

- Time: 10.00am to 2.00pm
- Venue: Invercargill

6.3 Competitor (& Service Crew) Briefing will take place as follows:

10. START ORDER, SEEDING & RESULTS

10.1 Provisional Start Order: Will be published on the Targa NZ Website www.targa.nz no later than two days before the start of the event and also on the Official Notice Board at the start of the event.

All competitors will be seeded on merit. All entrants are requested to record previous time trial experience on the entry form to assist with seeding. You are encouraged to do this to ensure an appropriate start position.

10.2 Provisional Results: will be posted on the Official Notice Board at the end of day venue and will also be available live on www.chrissport.co.nz

11. STAGE NOTES

The use of Stage Notes is strictly prohibited.

12. COMPETITOR RESPONSIBILITY

Any competitor reported to the Organiser prior to the commencement of the event for breaches of the civil road rules, or for bringing the event into disrepute, will be reported to the Vintage Car Club of NZ Inc.

13. CODE OF PRACTICE FUEL
