

SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS (TOUR)

TARGA TOUR PRINCIPLES & INTENT

The Tour is designed for people who have a special road legal car they do not want to fit with full rally safety equipment but want to experience driving their car following a predetermined route in an exciting non-competitive atmosphere. Cars with approved roll cages are only accepted at the discretion of the Organisers.

Management: The Tour is not a race. All cars travel in convoy on the route and their pace is governed by an experienced Tour Leader, with a Tour Follower vehicle. Additional Mid-Point officials may be included as required.

No overtaking is permitted on the closed road sections.

A Road Book is provided to aid with navigation on the event which also contains a "Slippery Surface" (yellow & red) and an "OK" (green) sign.

Speeding and Accidents will not be tolerated and will result in financial penalties and may lead to exclusion.

1. JURISDICTION

This event will be a **Tarmac Rally Touring Road** event known as “Targa Hawkes Bay 2020 Tour” hereafter referred to as “The Event”. Targa Hawkes Bay 2020 Tour will take place from **Friday 3rd July to Sunday 5th July**. The Event will be conducted under the **National Competition Rules (NCRs) of the Australian Auto-Sport Alliance Pty Ltd (AASA), the Series Regulations of the 2020 Targa Tour, these Supplementary Regulations, and any further regulations and bulletins which may be issued**. 3. THE EVENT

Targa Hawkes Bay 2020 Tour is a two (2) day Tarmac Tour event.

3.1 Venue: Targa Hawkes Bay 2020 Tour starts in **Havelock North** and travels through the **Hastings, Central Hawkes Bay and Tararua** districts and finishes in **Havelock North**.

There are **10** closed roads in total. This is broken down to **5** stages for Leg 1 and **5** stages for Leg 2

Service stops are as follows:

Leg 1 – **Napier, Havelock North and Waipawa**

Leg 2 – **Waipawa and Dannevirke**

3.2 Length: Comprises of approx. **296km** of closed roads and **470.40km** of touring.

3.3 Leg One – Saturday 4th July: First Car starts from Havelock North at 7:45am and finishes at 5:10pm in Havelock North.

3.4 Leg Two – Sunday 5th July: First Car starts from Havelock North at 8:15am and finishes at 3:45pm in Havelock North

4.3 Entry Acceptance: Entries shall be made online via the website www.targa.nz and to be deemed valid must complete all details and pay the appropriate fees. Acceptance will be at the Organising Committees' discretion. Organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry.

5. LICENCE REQUIREMENTS:

6. VEHICLE COMPLIANCE:

At all times vehicles shall comply with and display the NZ NZTA warrant of fitness and registration requirements. Refer to the Series Regulations governing the 2020 Targa NZ Tour, Regulation 6. Head lamps/driving lights must be on during the closed road sections.

Open Class Tour

Limited Class Tour

7. TRACKIT:

TrackIt units shall be installed as per the Series Regulations governing the 2020 Targa NZ Tour, Regulation 7.3. TrackIt units are available for lease from the Targa office.

8. SAFETY EQUIPMENT:

All vehicles shall have safety equipment as per the Series Regulations governing the 2020 Targa NZ Tour, Regulation 7.2.
