SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS (TOUR)

TARGA TOUR PRINCIPLES & INTENT

The Tour is designed for people who have a special road legal car they do not want to fit with full rally safety equipment but want to experience driving their car following a predetermined route in an exciting non-competitive atmosphere. Cars with approved roll cages are only accepted at the discretion of the Organisers.

Management: The Tour is not a race. All cars travel in convoy on the route and their pace is governed by an experienced Tour Leader, with a Tour Follower vehicle. Additional Mid-Point officials may be included as required.

No overtaking is permitted on the closed road sections.

A Road Book is provided to aid with navigation on the event which also contains a "Slippery Surface" (yellow & red) and an "OK" (green) sign.

Speeding and Accidents will not be tolerated and will result in financial penalties and may lead to exclusion.



1. JURISDICTION

This event will be a **Tarmac Rally Touring Road** event known as "Targa New Zealand 2021 Tour " hereafter referred to as "The Event". Targa New Zealand 2021 Tour will take place from **Tuesday 24th May to Sunday 29th May 2022**. The Event will be conducted under the **National Competition Rules (NCRs) of the Australian Auto-Sport Alliance Pty Ltd (AASA), the Series Regulations of the 2022 Targa Tour, these Supplementary Regulations, and any further regulations and bulletins which may be issued. By entering this event, you agree to comply with these regulations.**

3. <u>THE EVENT</u>

Targa New Zealand 2021 Tour is a five (5) day Tarmac Tour event.

3.1 Venue: Targa New Zealand 2021Tour starts in **New Plymouth** and travels through the **Waitomo**, **Otorohanga**, **New Plymouth**, **Stratford**, **South Taranaki**, **Whanganui**, **Ruapehu**, **Rangitikei**, **Hastings and Central Hawkes Bay** districts and finishes in **Havelock North**.

There are **28** closed roads in total. This is broken down to **5** closed roads for Leg 1, **5** closed roads for Leg 2, **7** closed stages for Leg 3, **6** closed roads for Legs 4 and **5** closed roads for Leg 5.

Service stops are as follows:

Leg 1 – Marakopa, Waitomo Caves, Te Kuiti, Piopio and Mokau

Leg 2 - Kaimata, Stratford, Whangamomona and Stratford

Leg 3 – Western Golf Course, Okato, Stratford and Hawera

Leg 4 – Waiouru and Taihape

Leg 5 – Taradale, Havelock North and Waipawa

3.2 Length: Comprises of approx. **747.23km** of closed roads and **1250.06km** of touring.

3.3 Leg One – Wednesday 25th May: First Car starts from New Plymouth at 7:00am and finishes at 4:50pm in New Plymouth.

3.4 Leg Two – Thursday 26th May: First Car starts from New Plymouth at 8:20am and finishes at 5:40pm in New Plymouth.

3.5 Leg Three – Friday 27th May: First Car starts from New Plymouth at 8:20am and finishes at 4:50pm in Whanganui.

3.6 Leg Four – Saturday 28th May: First Car starts from Whanganui at 8:00am and finishes at 2:55pm in Havelock North.

3.7 Leg Five – Sunday 29th May: First Car starts from Havelock North at 8:00am and finishes at 4:20pm in Havelock North.

4. ENTRIES

All listed fees are plus GST. The compulsory Medical Levy, Health & Safety and Trackit fees are payable in addition to the Entry Fee.

4.2 Entries are open from the publication of these Supplementary Regulations and close at **5:00pm** on **Friday 20th May 2022**.

4.3 Entry Acceptance: Entries shall be made online via the website <u>www.targa.nz</u> and to be deemed valid must complete all details and pay the appropriate fees. Acceptance will be at the Organising Committees' discretion. Organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry.

5. LICENCE REQUIREMENTS:

Refer to the Series Regulations governing the Targa New Zealand 2022 Tour, Regulation 3.

6. VEHICLE COMPLIANCE:

At all times vehicles shall comply with and display the NZ NZTA warrant of fitness and registration requirements. Refer to the Series Regulations governing the Targa New Zealand Tour 2022, Regulation 6. Head lamps/driving lights must be on during the closed road sections.

6.1 Targa Tour vehicles will be divided into the following categories:Open Class TourLimited Class Tour

Refer to Regulation 5 of the Tour Series Regulations.

7. TRACKIT:

TrackIt units shall be installed as per the Series Regulations governing the Targa New Zealand Tour 2022, Regulation 7.3. TrackIt units are available for lease from the Targa office.

8. SAFETY EQUIPMENT:

All vehicles shall have safety equipment as per the Series Regulations governing the Targa New Zealand Tour 2022, Regulation 7.2.
