



# Targa New Zealand Tour 2023

## SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS (TOUR) – Part 1

### TARGA TOUR PRINCIPLES & INTENT

The Tour is designed for people who have a special road legal car they do not want to fit with full rally safety equipment but want to experience driving their car following a predetermined route in an exciting non-competitive atmosphere. Cars with approved roll cages are only accepted at the discretion of the Organisers.

**Management:** The Tour is not a race. All cars travel in convoy on the route and their pace is governed by an experienced Tour Leader, with a Tour Follower vehicle. Additional Mid-Point officials may be included as required.

No overtaking is permitted on the closed road sections.

A Road Book is provided to aid with navigation on the event which also contains a “Slippery Surface” (yellow & red) and an “OK” (green) sign.

Speeding and Accidents will not be tolerated and will result in financial penalties and may lead to exclusion.

## 1. JURISDICTION

This event will be a **Tarmac Rally Touring Road** event known as “Targa New Zealand Tour 2023 ” hereafter referred to as “The Event”. Targa New Zealand 2023 Tour will take place from **Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> October to Saturday 28<sup>th</sup> October 2023**. The Event will be conducted under the **National Competition Rules (NCRs) of the Australian Auto-Sport Alliance Pty Ltd (AASA), the Series Regulations of the 2023 Targa Tour, these Supplementary Regulations, and any further regulations and bulletins which may be issued**. By entering this event, you agree to comply with these regulations.

### **3. THE EVENT**

**Targa New Zealand Tour 2023 is a five (5) day Tarmac Tour event.**

**3.1 Venue:** Targa New Zealand Tour 2023 starts at **Hampton Downs** and travels through the **Waikato, Waipa, Matamata-Piako, South Waikato, Otorohanga, Rotorua, Whakatane, Taupo, Ruapehu, Rangitikei, Manawatu, Tararua, Masterton and Carterton** districts and finishes in **Masterton**.

There are **29** closed roads in total. This is broken down to **6** closed roads for Leg 1, **7** closed roads for Leg 2, **6** closed stages for Leg 3, **5** closed roads for Legs 4 and **5** closed roads for Leg 5.

Service stops are as follows:

Leg 1 – **Hampton Downs, Tamahere, Matamata** and **Rotorua**

Leg 2 – **Arapuni, Putaruru** and **Rotorua**

Leg 3 – **Ngakuru, Taupo, Waiouru, Taihape, Manfeild** and **Palmerston North**

Leg 4 – **Apiti, Hunterville, Marton** and **Palmerston North**

Leg 5 – **Pahiatua, Eketahuna** and **Masterton**

**3.2 Length:** Comprises of approx. **590.56km** of closed roads and **1028.78km** of touring.

**3.3 Leg One** – Tuesday 24<sup>th</sup> October: First Car starts from Hampton Downs at 8:54am and finishes at 3:40pm in Rotorua.

**3.4 Leg Two** – Wednesday 25<sup>th</sup> October: First Car starts from Rotorua at 8:30am and finishes at 4:40pm in Rotorua.

**3.5 Leg Three** – Thursday 26<sup>th</sup> October: First Car starts from Rotorua at 8:15am and finishes at 5:35pm in Palmerston North.

**3.6 Leg Four** – Friday 27<sup>th</sup> October: First Car starts from Palmerston North at 8:30am and finishes at 3:50pm in Palmerston North.

**3.7 Leg Five** – Saturday 28<sup>th</sup> October: First Car starts from Palmerston North at 8:30am and finishes at 3:20pm in Masterton.

## 4. ENTRIES

All listed fees are plus GST. The compulsory Medical Levy, Health & Safety and RallySafe fees are payable in addition to the Entry Fee.

**4.2** Entries are open from the publication of these Supplementary Regulations and close at **5:00pm on Sunday 15<sup>th</sup> October 2023.**

**4.3 Entry Acceptance:** Entries shall be made online via the website [www.targa.nz](http://www.targa.nz) and to be deemed valid must complete all details and pay the appropriate fees. Acceptance will be at the Organising Committees' discretion. Organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry.

## 5. LICENCE REQUIREMENTS:

## 6. VEHICLE COMPLIANCE:

At all times vehicles shall comply with and display the NZ NZTA warrant of fitness and registration requirements. Refer to the Series Regulations governing the Targa New Zealand Tour 2023, Regulation 6. Head lamps/driving lights must be on during the closed road sections.

**Open Class Tour**

## 7. RSLite:

RSLite is a mobile application for Android and iOS which will be the GPS unit for Targa New Zealand Tour 2023. Instructions will be available at Drivers Briefing.

All vehicles shall have safety equipment as per the Series Regulations governing the Targa New Zealand Tour 2023, Regulation 7.2.
