SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS - TOUR - Part 1

TARGA TOUR PRINCIPLES & INTENT

The Tour is designed for people who have a special road legal car they do not want to fit with full rally safety equipment but want to experience driving their car following a predetermined route in an exciting non-competitive atmosphere. Cars with approved roll cages are only accepted at the discretion of the Organisers.

Management: The Tour is not a race. All cars travel in convoy on the route and their pace is governed by an experienced Tour Leader, with a Tour Follower vehicle. Additional Mid-Point officials may be included as required.

No overtaking is permitted on the closed road sections.

A Road Book is provided to aid with navigation on the event which also contains a "Slippery Surface" (yellow & red) and an "OK" (green) sign.

Speeding and Accidents will not be tolerated and will result in financial penalties and may lead to exclusion.



1. JURISDICTION

This event will be a **Tarmac Touring Road** event known as "Targa New Zealand Tour 2024" hereafter referred to as "The Event". Targa New Zealand 2024 Tour will take place from **Thursday 24th October** to **Monday 28th October 2024.** The Event will be conducted under the **National Competition Rules** (NCRs) of the Australian Auto-Sport Alliance Pty Ltd (AASA), the Series Regulations of the 2024 Targa Tour, these Supplementary Regulations, and any further regulations and bulletins which may be issued. By entering this event, you agree to comply with these regulations.

3. THE EVENT

Targa New Zealand Tour 2024 is a four (4) day Tarmac Tour event.

3.1 Venue: Targa New Zealand 2024 Competition starts at **Otorohanga** and travels through the **Waitomo**, **Waipa**, **Matamata-Piako**, **South Waikato**, **Otorohanga and Rotorua Lakes**, districts and finishes in **Rotorua**. There are **25** stages in total. This is broken down to **7** stages for Leg 1, **6** stages for Leg 2, **6** stages for Leg 3 & **6** stages for Legs 4.

Service stops are as follows:

- Leg 1 Otorohanga and Te Anga.
- Leg 2 Otorohanga, Wharepapa South and Rotorua
- Leg 3 Matamata, Cambridge and Rotorua
- Leg 4 **Ngakuru** and **Tokoroa**
- **3.2 Length:** Comprises of approx. **571.03km** of closed roads and **688.87km** of touring.
- **3.3 Leg One** Friday 25th October: First Car starts from Otorohanga at 8:45am and finishes at 4:20pm in Otorohanga.
- **3.4 Leg Two** Saturday 26th October: First Car starts from Otorohanga at 8:45am and finishes at 4:40pm in Rotorua.
- **3.5 Leg Three** Sunday 27th October: First Car starts from Rotorua at 8:15am and finishes at 4:20pm in Rotorua.
- **3.6 Leg Four** Monday 28th October: First Car starts from Rotorua at 8:40am and finishes at 2:55pm in Rotorua.

4. ENTRIES

4.2 Entries are open from the publication of these Supplementary Regulations and close at **5:00pm** on **Thursday 17th October 2024.**



4.3 Entry Acceptance: Entries shall be made online via the website www.targa.nz and to be deemed valid must complete all details and pay the appropriate fees. Acceptance will be at the Organising Committees' discretion. Organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry.

5. LICENCE REQUIREMENTS:

6. VEHICLE COMPLIANCE:

At all times vehicles shall comply with and display the NZ NZTA warrant of fitness and registration requirements. Refer to the Series Regulations governing the Targa New Zealand Tour 2024, Regulation 6. Head lamps/driving lights must be on during the closed road sections.

7. RSLite:

RSLite is a mobile application for Android and iOS which will be the GPS unit for Targa New Zealand Tour 2024. Instructions will be available at Drivers Briefing.

8. <u>SAFETY EQUIPMENT:</u>

All vehicles shall have safety equipment as per the Series Regulations governing the Targa New Zealand Tour 2024, Regulation 7.2.
